Dear DCSC Parents and Guardians,

We have made important updates to our DCSC 2020-2021 School Year Planning Guide that we wanted to share with you. The updated guide is attached, and you can always find the most up-to-date version on our website at www.danville.k12.in.us/Page/694. Additionally, we wanted to bring to your attention to the change log at the end of the guide. Any changes we make to the guide are noted at the end of the document in the change log.

Here are two updates we think you might find important:

- In Governor Eric Holcomb's Executive Order 20-39, special requirements were added for K-12 educational institutes. To follow these requirements, our face mask policy has changed slightly. All DCSC staff and students, preschool to 12th grade, will be required to wear a face mask at all times. However, some exclusions apply and frequent breaks throughout the day will be allowed. Face masks will not be required during lunch, strenuous activity, and recess when social distancing can be achieved. Classroom face mask breaks will also be allowed when students are seated in rows, facing forward and distanced. See Section I, A, 1 of the DCSC 2020-2021 School Year Planning Guide for complete mask guidelines.
- We added clarification in the guide for how instruction will continue during a short-term closure. Should our school buildings need to close for a short period of time, all students attending school in-person will shift to eLearning at home. All DCSC Online students will continue with their virtual program.

Families will be receiving updates on the DCSC Online program today. Building-level specific guides are also being sent to families this afternoon for both the elementary level and the secondary level.

We are looking forward to welcoming your child back to school for in-person or virtual education!
