If you are an Indiana 7th or 8th grade student who qualifies for the program, you can get up to four years of free college tuition to attend an eligible Indiana public or private college, university or proprietary institution.

**All you have to do is:**

1. Apply for the program by the application deadline. (June of the student’s 8th grade year)
2. Fulfill the Scholars pledge to the state of Indiana.
3. Meet the guidelines for Indiana student financial aid.

**You qualify if you:**

- Meet Indiana residency guidelines
- Meet U.S. citizenship qualifications
- Are enrolled in seventh or eighth grade in an approved Indiana school
- Fulfill the Twenty-first Century Scholars Pledge
- Meet income eligibility requirements
